COMPETITION CONDITIONS

The WPPT is organized by the company World Pitch & Putt Tour SL

The WPPT is supported by FIPPA, by agreement between the two parties and with the approval of the FIPPA member where the competition is held.

RIGHT TO PLAY

All players with a valid license from a FIPPA and Noth Portugal member will be eligible to play the PORTUGAL MASTER.

REGISTRATION FOR THE COMPETITION

Player registrations must be made via email at info@wppt.es and payment must be made by bank transfer to the WPPT account. In order to complete the registration, a form must be filled out and the WPPT rules and regulations must be explicitly accepted.

GAME FORMAT

Players will play 36 holes in individual stroke play on Saturday.

On Sunday they will play 18 holes in individual stroke play in reverse order of classification.

RULES OF THE GAME

The game will be played under the FIPPA rules in force, currently those approved on April 1, 2020.

DEPARTURE TIME

The tee times will be determined by the WPPT in an attempt to take into account the preferences of the players. The competition will be played on Saturday and Sunday.

Each player will play 36 holes on Saturday, unless the Competition Committee decides to modify this for exceptional reasons.

PROVISIONAL AGENDA

The first group start on Saturday will be at 8:30 AM, and the second start will be at 13:30 PM.

The second group start on Saturday will be at 11:00 AM, and the second start will be at 16:00 PM.

Between the first and second rounds, players will have a minimum of one hour to eat and rest.

Sunday Start:

Players ranked 33rd to 72th will start at 9:00 AM.

Players ranked 1st to 36nd will start at 12:00 PM.

The two groups with the highest-ranked players will start with an 8-minute interval from the 1st tee.

WPPT will provide breakfast on Friday and Saturday between 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM.

Players will have access to water and fruit throughout the competition.

The award ceremony and raffle will take place on Sunday at 3:30 PM.

ECONOMIC PRIZES

The prizes that the WPPT will give before taxes and withholdings will be the following:

Winner 500€

2nd position 350€

3rd position 250€

4th position 200€

5th position 100€

Pilar Montero Trophy for the best ranked lady: winner **€200**

John Manning Trophy for the best ranked senior aged 55 or over: winner **€200**

Intermediate (hcp 0 to 7) 1st **100€**

Novel (hcp 8 to 21) 1st **100€**

In the event that the winner of the women's trophy or the winner of the senior trophy is also awarded in the absolute classification, he or she will be awarded the highest cash prize.

TIE-BREAKERS

In the event of a tie for the champion position in any category, the tied players will play hole by hole in a "sudden death" format until the tie is broken, starting with the hole determined by the Competition Committee and following the order of designated holes.

In the event of a tie for any other prize money position, the prize money for the positions will be added together and divided equally between the players tied for the same position.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The Organizing Committee will be made up of members of the WPPT.

The suspension of the test prior to its celebration is the responsibility of this committee.

COMPETITION COMMITTEE

It will be made up of members of the WPPT.

The Competition Committee may redefine the competition due to weather conditions or force majeure.

The suspension of the test during its celebration is the responsibility of this committee.

The minimum number of holes played to award prizes will be 36 holes.
